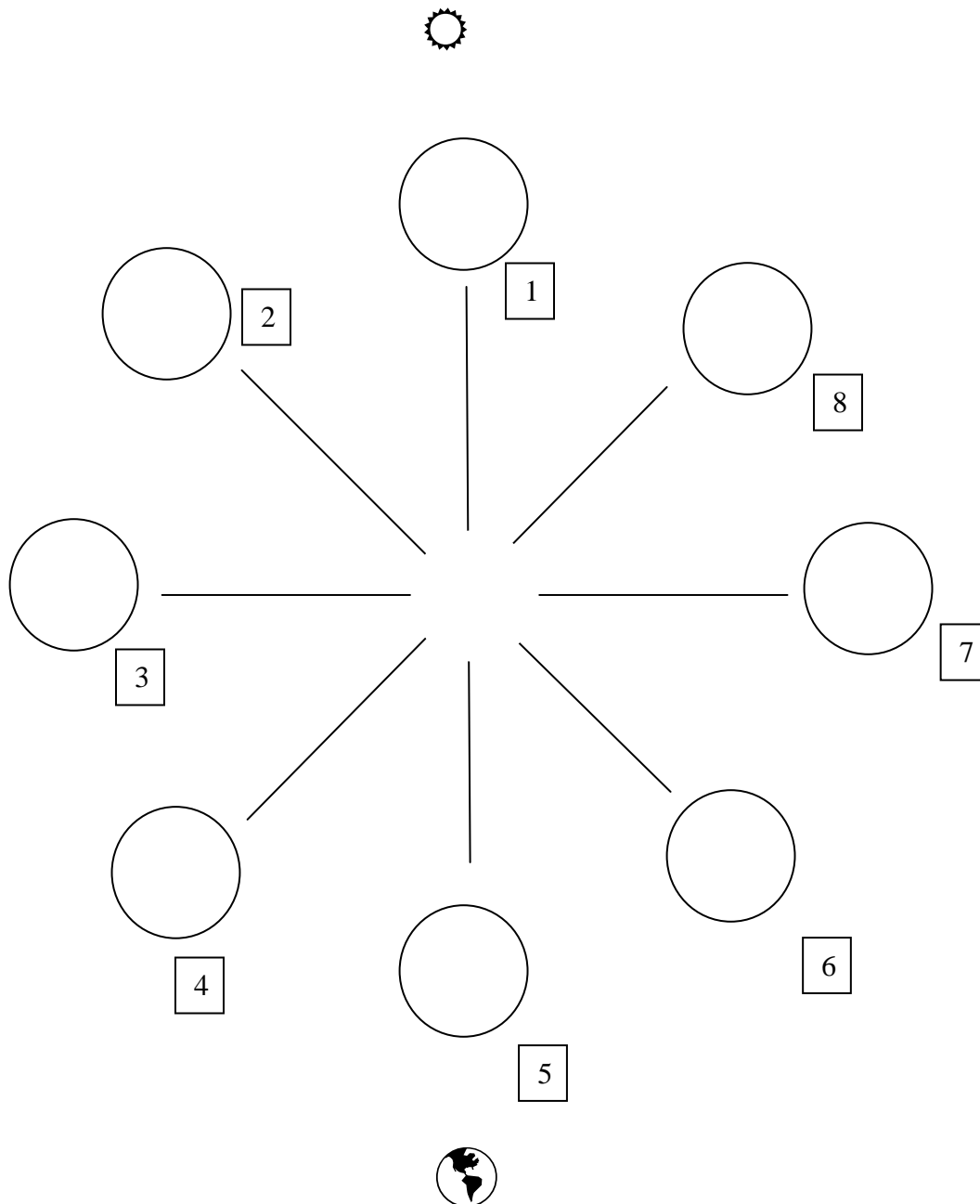
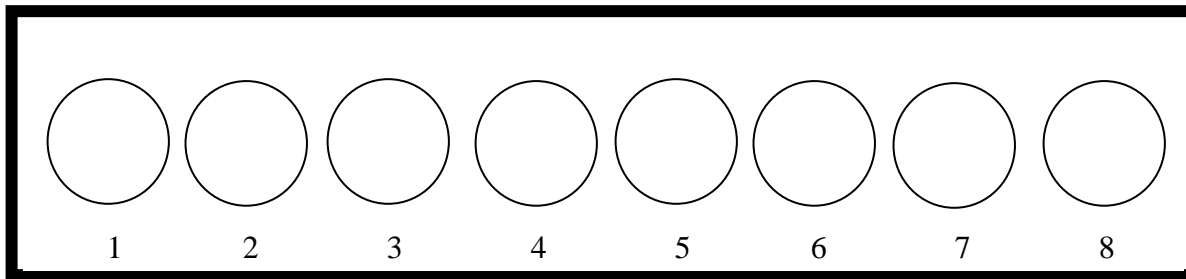




# Theory of the Universe Plotting Sheet

Place the observer's position (i.e. on Earth) at the Earth Symbol .

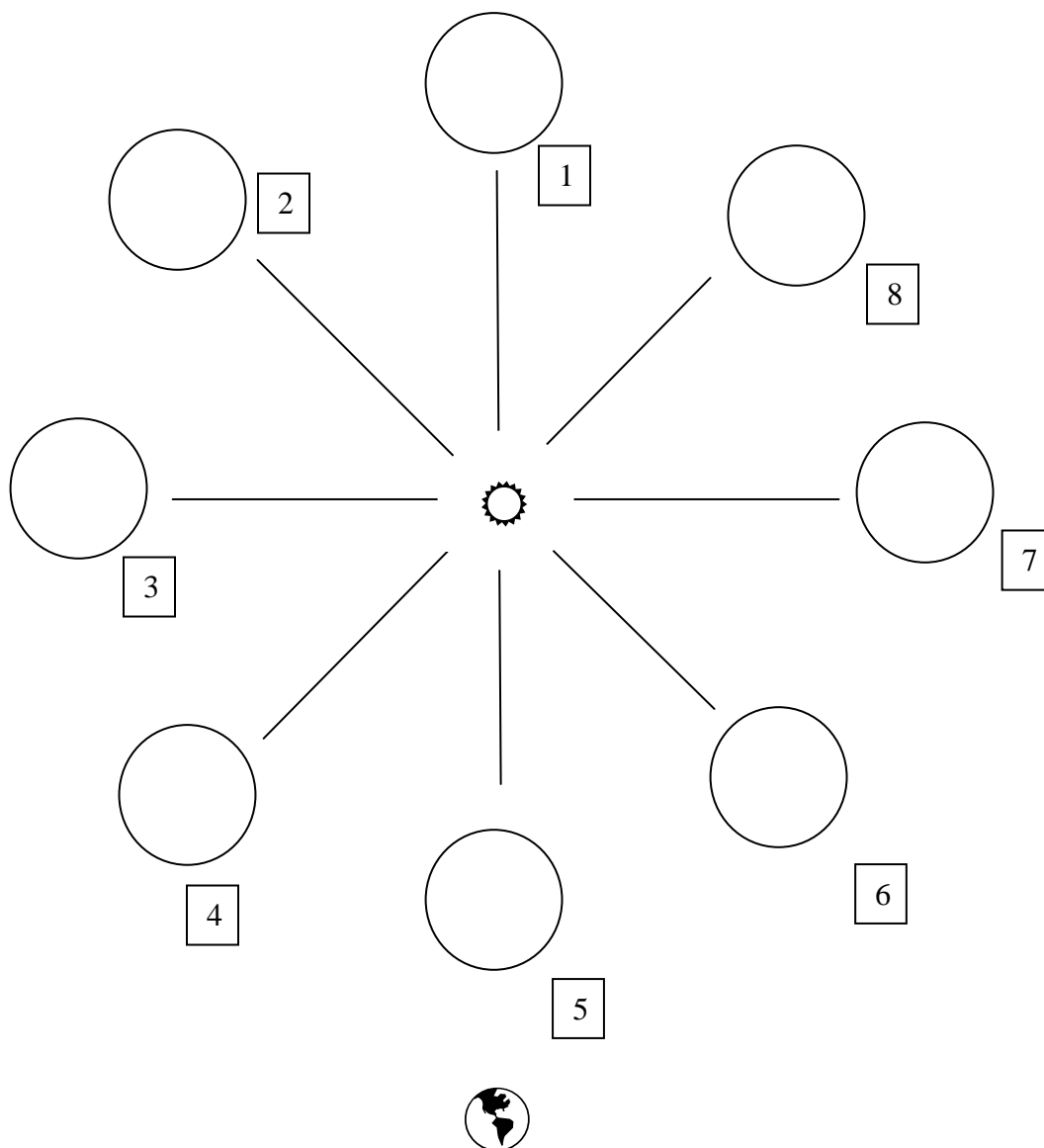
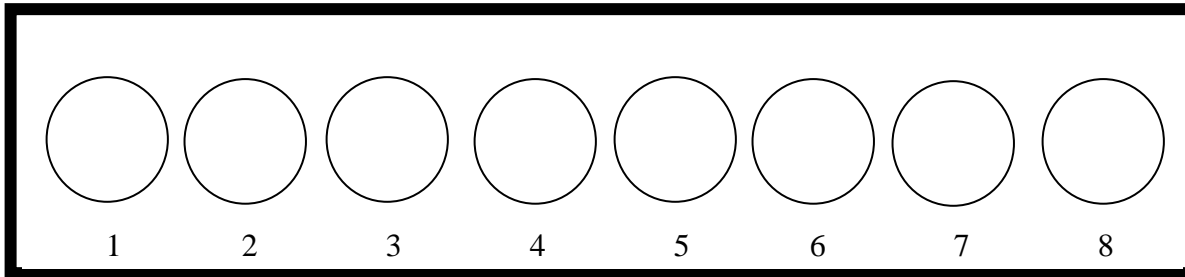
The Sun symbol,  is where the Sun is located for this theory and should be where the light bulb is.
